Jurnal Ekonomi dan Bisnis Islam (JEBIS) has come to its 6th volume since the first issue in the mid of 2015. The incoming article has been reviewed by a minimum of two reviewers that ultimately will be selected by the editor in chief in a forum of the editorial board meeting. In addition, maintaining the

quality and originality of the article is also carried out with a plagiarism test using Turnitin software.

So far, JEBIS has achieved a good number of visitors. At the beginning of the 6th volume publication on June 30, 2020, the number of page views reached 803 with 86 visitors. For the average, the daily visitor in the Open Journal System is 58.4 per day, while the page view is 264.4 per day. The number is vital to broadening the scope of JEBIS readers. Therefore, each article published in JEBIS will bring a higher impact on the progress of the development of Islamic economics, particularly within the area of developing economies.
